Unable to feel or move his body, even his face was paralyzed... he was “locked in.” The prognosis for this type of midbrain stroke is universally death without immediate intervention. The physicians of Atlanta Neurology and AcuteCare Teleneurology provided aggressive care. Timely infusion of a clot-busting agent, t-PA, opened the basilar artery immediately reversing the potentially fatal stroke.
